Wireless gadgets so you can un-tether your tunes

SINCE MOTHER'S DAY IS ALL ABOUT cutting the cord, so to speak, why not celebrate the holiday this May by surrounding yourself with all sorts of cool wireless audio systems? Sennheiser's audiophile-grade **1. RS 170 wireless headphones** (\$329.95, [www.sennheiser-usa.com](http://www.sennheiser-usa.com)) offer home-theater-friendly surround-sound simulation. Utilizing Klear's uncompressed digital wireless audio transmission, they boast wired-sounding interference-free reception for as many as four pairs of compatible headphones at a range of up to 260 feet. And if you have headphones that aren't already wireless, make them wireless by plugging into Aerielle Technologies'

**2. i2i Stream** (\$99.95, [www.aerielle.com](http://www.aerielle.com)). These ultra-compact 2.4 GHz transceivers enable a plethora of un-tethering scenarios, such as sharing tunes from a friend's mp3 player or streaming jukebox-style from your computer to your home stereo. For a multi-room wireless audio solution, IntelliTouch's **3. Eos Wireless Converge system** (\$99.95-\$249.95 per component, [www.eoswireless.com](http://www.eoswireless.com)) is the way to go. Start with a little stand-alone component or iPod dock as your transmitter, add one of their amped or un-amped receivers, and you're in business! Thanks to Eos' proprietary GigaWave technology, whatever configuration you choose will allow you to groove to any and all music files (even DRM) anywhere you roam inside your house within 150 feet. If you should happen to leave the house, you'll appreciate the portability of Spracht's stylish, award-winning **4. Aura BluNote Speaker** (\$99, [www.spracht.com](http://www.spracht.com)). It offers rich bass and stereo widening, stores up to eight Bluetooth profiles, and can be

used as a speakerphone with your cell. Plus, it comes with a 3.5mm jack, so you can rock out to tracks from your non-Bluetooth devices too. Lastly, Audiovox's **5. AW828 Wireless speaker with built-in planter** (\$129, [www.araccessories.com](http://www.araccessories.com)) gives mom a plant *and* a great omnidirectional wireless speaker. The plant and speaker separate for easier potting. And the drainage is purposefully set up in a way that won't cause Mom to have an unintended hair-curling experience.
